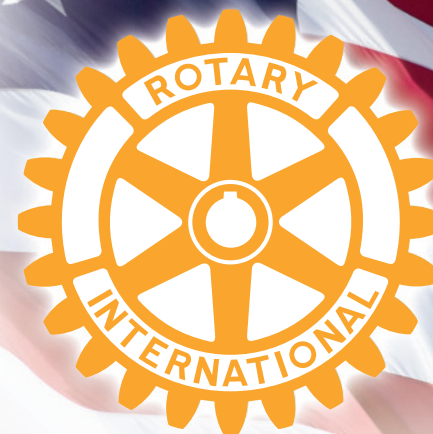

# Flag Program

We started the flag program in 1999 and have been proudly displaying the US flag in various neighborhoods since. What started as a very humble endeavor has grown to more than 500 flags being displayed each holiday. **The fee is \$50 per year for five (5) holidays.** We currently display the flags in 13 areas in Temple. As much as we would like to display them all over the city, we physically cannot. We need to keep the flags concentrated in the established routes in order to maintain efficiency in drop off and pick up.

The flag will be set in place (weather permitting) by 8:00 a.m. in a previously prepared metal sleeve placed in the ground. The flag will be picked up by sunset on these days.

Organizations benefitting from financial contributions from the club include the Temple Literacy Council and the Temple Education Foundation. In partnership with Temple Fire & Rescue, Rotarians visit neighborhoods throughout Temple to install smoke detectors in homes that do not have one. To promote the health and welfare of our citizens, the club donated automated external defibrillators (AEDs) to support the city's public access defibrillation program and to save lives. The Ronald McDonald House in Temple was built, in part, with funds donated by the Rotary Club of Temple-South. The club is also proud to have been a major contributor to Temple's All Access Playground for disabled children. Members of the club enjoy fellowship activities throughout the year in which family and friends can participate. Weekly club meetings provide a variety of stimulating and interesting programs and allow Rotarians to experience the warm fellowship of the club.
